CSLAP: The Citizens Statewide Lake Assessment Program (CSLAP), created in 1985, is a volunteer lake monitoring program run by the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) and the NYS Federation of Lake Associations, Inc. (NYSFOLA).

NYSFOLA: The New York State Federation of Lake Associations (NYSFOLA) is a not-for-profit coalition of lake associations and others interested in lake management. NYSFOLA was founded in 1983 and presently serves nearly 200 lake associations as well as individual and corporate members.

BRASS: The Bouquet River Association (BRASS) is a non-profit association dedicated to enhancing the quality of water and life in the Bouquet River watershed.

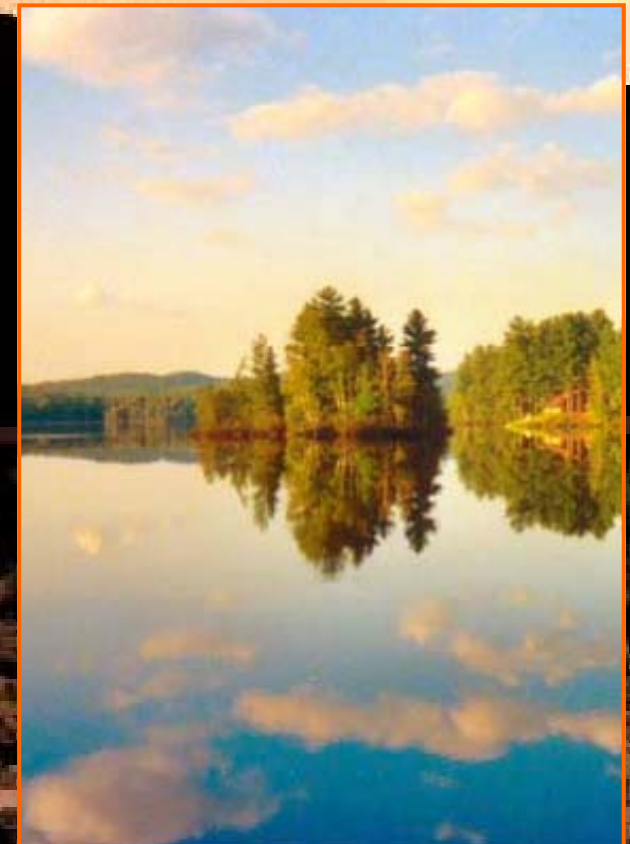
